- **What to wear:** Old clothes – long-sleeve tops, trousers, waterproofs and gardening or work gloves (we can lend you some!) Covering arms and legs is important as you might be pulling out Himalayan balsam in nettles and thistles! Wear wellies or sturdy shoes/boots.
- **What to bring:** Drinks, hats, sunscreen and waterproofs (just in case) and lunch if you're staying all day.
- **Parking:** Parking is very limited. Please walk or use public transport.
- **U18s** must be accompanied by an adult.
